# **QUARTERLY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS**

10 AM | July 8, 2020 Zoom Webinar

#### 1. Call to Order

Committee co-chair Barry Seymour of DVRPC called the quarterly freight advisory committee meeting to order. Mr. Seymour welcomed all task force members and friends, and attendees were invited to introduce themselves and their affiliations in the chat box of the webinar.

# 2. Navigating Disruption: An Industry Conversation on the Regional Impacts of COVID-19

Industry representatives from Evans Network of Delivery Companies and JLL joined the committee for a panel discussion on the implications and challenges that have faced truckers and industry in the region since the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic. Gerry Coyle of Evans Network of Companies and Larry Maister of JLL, representing the Northeast Industrial market region, provided the committee with valuable insights and a lively discussion. Highlights included the impacts to port activity and the booming industrial market. The discussion also covered forward looking implications of COVID-19, some of which remain promising as the industrial market continues to grow in the Greater Philadelphia region. The panel provided committee members with additional insights into how markets have shifted and emphasized the critical role that goods movement and distribution facilities have had, especially during the disruption over the second quarter of 2020.

# 3. Connections 2050 Visioning Exercise

DVRPC is embarking on the next long-range plan, Connections 2050. As a component of the outreach to craft a vision for the Greater Philadelphia region, the committee participated in a facilitated visioning exercise. Mike Boyer of DVRPC introduced the current long-range plan and shared a summary of the Direction 2020 plan, DVRPC's long-range plan created in the early 1990's for 2020. Mr. Boyer with support from Kristen Scudder, led the committee through questions on what members value most and what concerns them most about the region with a focus on business and goods movement perspectives. Mr. Boyer introduce the Future Forces being considered as part of the 2050 plan which include: Rising Inequality, Digital Revolution, and Climate Change. Members were then asked to share their vision for the region and an aspirational tweet or headline they would like to see in 2050.

The session closed out with a request for input on what members want to see more of at future committee meetings and were reminded of other ways to provide input to the Connections 2050 plan. More information is available at: www.dvrpc.org/2050.
