

QUARTERLY MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

10 AM | January 13, 2021 Zoom Webinar

1. Call to Order

Committee co-chair Barry Seymour of DVRPC called the quarterly freight advisory committee meeting to order. Mr. Seymour welcomed all task force members and friends.

2. Greater Philadelphia Freight Activity in 2020

Mike Ruane, Manager of the Office of Freight and Aviation at DVRPC, provided a highlight of key projects and initiatives from the year as well as a review of key freight and industrial real estate trends from 2020. DVRPC's ongoing freight planning efforts include the Chester County Freight Plan, a municipal planning guidebook, the Philadelphia Truck Route Planning Guidebook, freight rail data visualization, and updates to the Philly Freight Finder web application.

Mike shared that in 2020, the greater Philadelphia region saw decreased maritime imports and increased maritime exports, with PhilaPort reporting an increase in total containerized cargo through October. While commercial flight operations where significantly decreased as a result of COVID, PHL reported a two percent growth in air cargo and an 86 percent increase in air mail. Norfolk Southern also began service to the South Philadelphia Navy Yard this year, linking the Southport Glovis America facilities to the North American market via rail. Market trends continue to show an acceleration of growth in distribution center development across the region with five million square feet of new industrial development completed in 2020 and even more expected in 2021.

3. Pennsylvania Freight Movement Plan

Pennsylvania DOT is preparing a statewide Freight Movement Plan, as required by the Federal Highway Administration, and stakeholder engagement is essential and a high priority for plan development and implementation.

The Pennsylvania DOT primary consulting team presented an overview of the plan process and updates for the ongoing 2045 Pennsylvania Comprehensive Freight Movement Plan. Four priority goals have been identified and include aligning freight mobility with economic development and land use; improving multimodal freight transportation operations and safety; advancing project investments that enhance freight mobility; and providing planning, data, and analytical tools for improved decision making. This presentation was followed by an interactive conversation about the goals and initial findings of the plan using the interactive polling tool, Mentimeter.

The task force identified "Aligning freight mobility with economic development and land use" as the top priority goal for task force engagement and "Amending the Municipal Planning Code" as the top option for improving the freight-land use and economic development connection. Discussion was had around the relative impact of truck parking approaches, and in a poll "Requiring new freight-generating developments to provide parking/ staging facilities" was selected as the most impactful approach. Open input was also collected on strategies that the Comprehensive Freight Movement Plan could use to advance each of the four priority goals. These perspectives from the task force on freight movement, in both the DVRPC region and the state, will help to inform the plan development.

Carl BelkeStrategic Rail Finance

Announced that the Pennsylvania Governor's office released \$31M in rail infrastructure grants this week through the Rail Transportation Assistance Program (RTAP) and the Rail Freight Assistance Program (RFAP). In the DVRPC region, project funds have been awarded to CSX for clearance improvements into the Port of Philadelphia, to Pennsylvania Northern Railroad for track improvements, and to East Penn Railroad, LLC for track improvements.
