

DELAWARE VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION REGIONAL TECHNICAL COMMITTEE February 11, 2014 Meeting Highlights DVRPC Conference Room, Philadelphia, PA

1. Call to Order - Chairperson's Comments

Andrew Levecchia (Chairperson, Camden County) welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order.

2. Deputy Planning Director's Report

John Ward (DVRPC) announced that the Board approved all of the Action Items recommended by the committee at the RTC meeting on January 7, 2014 including approval of the FY15 Work Program, which includes SRHP and TSP work scopes.

Mr. Ward called the RTC's attention to the NJ Strategic Highway Safety Plan Kick-off Webinar, which will take place at the beginning of March and will include a one-day workshop later that month. He encouraged New Jersey RTC members to keep their eyes open for an invitation to participate.

Mr. Ward noted that several new reports have recently been published by DVRPC. One report, titled 2012 Annual Crash Data Bulletin, focuses this year on seniors and travel issues related to seniors. Additional reports are: The County Crash Fact Sheet, 2012/2013 Aircraft Operations Counting Program, and the CMP Newsletter.

Mr. Ward reminded RTC members that there are several meetings taking place at DVRPC in the month of March. Some of the meetings include the Public Participation Task Force meeting, which will take place March 4, the Information Resources Exchange Group meeting, taking place March 5, and the Regional Safety Task Force meeting, taking place March 6.

Mr. Ward noted that the next RTC meeting will be taking place on March 11.

5. <u>DVRPC Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Actions</u>

Elizabeth Schoonmaker (DVRPC) presented four TIP amendments for consideration.

a. NJ14-13: Burlington County ATMS Upgrade & CR 656 DMS Deployment (DB# TBD1) Burlington County - Add a Proposed New Project

Burlington County has requested that DVRPC amend the FY2014 - 2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$1,701,000 State-DVRPC funded project, Burlington County ATMS Upgrade & CR 656 DMS Deployment, (DB# TBD1) for construction in FY14.

b. NJ14-14: Reconstruction of Grove Street (CR 644), (DB# TBD2) Camden County - Add a Proposed New Project

Camden County has requested that DVRPC amend the FY2014 - 2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$2,040,000 STP-STU funded project, Reconstruction of Grove Street, (DB# TBD2) for construction in FY14. Funds will be made available from \$8,518,000 additional obligation authority provided by NJDOT to DVRPC for FY14 (see TIP Action NJ12-82).

c. NJ14-15: Resurfacing and Safety Improvements on Tuckahoe Road (CR 557) (DB# TBD3) Gloucester County - Add a Proposed New Project

Gloucester County has requested that DVRPC amend the FY2014 - 2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$2,500,000 STP-STU funded project, Resurfacing and Safety Improvements on Tuckahoe Road (CR 557), (DB# TBD3) for construction in FY14. Funds will be made available from \$8,518,000 additional obligation authority provided by NJDOT to DVRPC for FY14 (see TIP Action NJ12-82).

d. NJ14-16: Resurfacing and Safety Improvements on Woodbury-Glassboro Road (CR 553) (DB# TBD4) Gloucester County - Add a Proposed New Project

Gloucester County has requested that DVRPC amend the FY2014 - 2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$3,250,000 STP-STU funded project, Resurfacing and Safety Improvements on Woodbury-Glassboro Road (CR 553), (DB# TBD4) for construction in FY14. Funds will be made available from \$8,518,000 additional obligation authority provided by NJDOT to DVRPC for FY14 (see TIP Action NJ12-82).

Motion: by Matthew Lawson, seconded by Jessica Lucas to recommend the Board approve the following TIP Actions:

NJ14-13, Burlington County's request that DVRPC amend the FY2014 -2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$1,701,000 State-DVRPC funded project, Burlington County ATMS Upgrade & CR 656 DMS Deployment, (DB# TBD1) for construction in FY14.

NJ14-14, Camden County's request that DVRPC amend the FY2014 - 2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$2,040,000 STP-STU funded project, Reconstruction of Grove Street, (DB# TBD2) for construction in FY14.

NJ14-15, Gloucester County's request that DVRPC amend the FY2014 -2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$2,500,000 STP-STU funded project, Resurfacing and Safety Improvements on Tuckahoe Road (CR 557), (DB# TBD3) for construction in FY14.

NJ14-16, Gloucester County's request that DVRPC amend the FY2014 - 2017 TIP for New Jersey by adding a new \$3,250,000 STP-STU funded project, Resurfacing and Safety Improvements on Woodbury-Glassboro Road (CR 553), (DB# TBD4) for construction in FY14.

Motion passed. All votes were cast in favor of the motion.

6. Fiscal Year 2014 Planning Work Program Amendments

To respond to the needs of member governments and agencies, work program changes and additions are brought to the RTC to permit the timely undertaking of technical activity.

a. Technical Assistance for Implementation of the Circuit

Shawn Megill-Legendre (DVRPC) presented a new project, which will provide technical assistance to trail managers, builders, and advocates for planning, design, construction and funding of Circuit trails

Motion: by Thomas Shaffer, seconded by Barbara Holcomb, to recommend the Board amend the FY2014 Planning Work Program to add the Technical Assistance for Implementation of the Circuit Program.

Motion passed. All votes were cast in favor of the motion.

7. Project Evaluation Criteria for New TIP Projects

Elizabeth Schoonmaker (DVRPC) clarified that in order to help inform the selection process for new projects to be included in the DVRPC PA and NJ Transportation Improvement Programs, DVRPC has been working with its planning partners to update the region's Project Evaluation Criteria for new TIP projects. DVRPC asked for a recommendation on weighted criteria that have been developed through this process.

Motion: by Jim Mosca, seconded by Michael Carroll, to recommend the Board approve the Project Evaluation Criteria for New TIP Projects.

Motion passed. All votes were cast in favor of the motions.

8. US 30 Eastern Radnor Township Traffic and Circulation Study

Keith Hartington (DVRPC) presented on this recently completed study, examining existing, proposed and potential pedestrian and vehicular traffic issues along US 30 in the vicinity of Villanova University.

9. FY 15 Draft Transportation Management Association Assistance Grant Program and Mobility Alternatives Program Work Scopes Review

Sarah Oaks (DVRPC) explained that each January, the Transportation Management Associations and Mobility Alternatives Program Contractors are asked to provide staff and member government stakeholders with draft work scopes for the upcoming fiscal year. FY 15 work scopes have been received and are currently being reviewed by the DVRPC TMA Policy Committee. DVRPC staff provided highlights of the Programs and will request comments by February 21st.
