# September 13, 2016 Meeting Highlights DVRPC Conference Room, Philadelphia, PA

#### 1. Call to Order - Chairperson's Comments

Thomas Shaffer (Chair, Delaware County) welcomed RTC members and called the meeting to order.

#### 2. <u>Deputy Executive Director's Report</u>

DVRPC Deputy Executive Director John Ward announced that the Board approved all the recommendations that the RTC forwarded to them from the July RTC meeting including some very important actions such as: 2045 population forecasts, a LRP Amendment, a Conformity Determination and a PA TIP.

DVRPC also provided comment to the Docket on the NPRM for System Performance, Freight, and CMAQ Performance Measures. The Commission also coordinated on a comment letter with other MPOs, DOTs, and Transit Operators in the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic.

Mr. Ward noted that a New Jersey TAP round has recently opened and applications are due to NJ DOT by November 10<sup>th</sup>. Workshops for potential applicants are being set up and information will be posted on our website soon.

On June 30th, Governor Christie issued an Executive Order which declared a State of Emergency in New Jersey and ordered the shut-down of Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) Authority-funded projects. The legislature and the Governor have been discussing ways to re-fill the TTF but they have not been able to agree on a solution yet.

Mr. Ward called the RTC's attention to some new releases including: 2014/15 Aircraft Operations Counting Program: Operations for Six Non-Towered Airports; Data Bulletin #097: Population Estimates, 2010-2015; Analytical Data Report #022: County- and Municipal-Level Population Forecasts, 2015-2045; Data Bulletin #098: Residential Building Permits, 2010-2015; 2015 Transportation Safety Action Plan: Improving Transportation Safety in the Delaware Valley; Downtown Trenton Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.

Mr. Ward announced some upcoming meetings including: Information Resources Exchange Group (IREG) - 100<sup>th</sup> Meeting September 14, Regional Aviation Committee Meeting September 15, TOTF/FHWA Operations Scenario Planning - September 29, and the DVRPC Board meeting September 22.

Mr. Ward reminded RTC members that the next RTC meeting will be taking place on **Tuesday, October 11, 2016.**

#### 4. Highlights of the Meeting of July 12, 2016

#### 5. MPO Transportation Planning and Programming Memoranda of Understanding

John Ward, DVRPC, presented multiple memoranda of understanding between DVRPC and neighboring MPOs (LCTCC, NJTPA, SJTPO, and WILMAPCO) regarding their transportation planning and programming responsibilities as they relate to established urbanized areas that cross defined MPO boundaries. These MOUs will be updated

following each decennial census and the development of new urbanized areas by the US Census Bureau.

Motion: by Andrew Levecchia, seconded by Barbara Holcomb that the RTC recommend the Board adopt the MOUs .

Motion passed. All votes were cast in favor of the motion.

#### 6. <u>Proposed Dates for Calendar Year 2017 RTC Meetings</u>

The proposed dates for calendar year 2017 RTC meetings were presented for approval.

#### 7. SEP-TAINABLE 2020

Rebecca Collins, SEPTA, explained that SEPTA's first-generation Sustainability Program Plan was formally adopted by the SEPTA Board in January 2011. The plan focused on 12 targets to be reached by 2015 and served as the framework for initiatives to advance the environmental, social and economic sustainability of the system and region. It has become a model for collaborative sustainability planning and implementation in the transit industry. The results from the 2015 plan were presented along with a proposed planning framework for the 2020 plan.

#### 8. Data Coordination Initiative at DVRPC

Kim Korejko, DVRPC, and Sean Lawrence, DVRPC, presented on new data coordination efforts that are underway at DVRPC. Through this initiative, staff are working toward improving how DVRPC acquires, stores, manages, maintains, and shares data. Related to this initiative, a demonstration of the recently released GIS Data Portal was given.
