ERH HAS YOU COVERED

EMERGENCIES ARE EVEN **WORSE** WHEN YOU DON'T DRIVE TO WORK



That's why we offer the **Emergency Ride Home** program, known as **ERH**. If you commute in a carpool, a vanpool or by public transportation, you may worry about what happens if you have to address an **emergency during work hours**. Without a car, you may feel **stranded** – but you don't have to! **ERH can help**.

If you **work** in **southeastern Pennsylvania**, and **share** your commute at least three days a week, you can sign up for ERH (see other side).

REGISTERING FOR AND USING ERH IS EASY!

- Go to www.pacarpool.org and click on the ERH icon.
- Fill out the simple online form and wait for confirmation.
- If a true emergency arises during work hours, on a day when you do not have a car on-site, you can secure an alternate way to get wherever you need to be (taxi, on-demand service, rental car, carshare vehicle, co-worker).
- Then obtain a receipt and submit it with our form (on the webpage) for reimbursement.
- You may use the ERH service two times a calendar year, and may be reimbursed up to \$50 each time (for no more than \$100 total), if the trip is approved.



ERH is part of the Mobility Alternatives Program (MAP) administered by the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC) with funding from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT).
