Comment/Question: This is good news for pedestrian access on both sides but there was no mention of bike lanes, my question is will there be an installation of bike lanes if there is space.

Response: Your comment was shared with the DVRPC Board, DVRPC's Office of Capital Programs, Montgomery County, and PennDOT.

From PennDOT Project Manager: There are no bike lanes anticipated to be added as part of the project. There are no shoulders along Old York Road in either direction today and the project limits are only from Rodman Avenue to Baeder Road on either side of the bridge.

Additional background information Matt Popek shared (Montco):

Montgomery County views bike lanes as important corridor projects that should be planned out with attention paid to current traffic volumes and availability of alternate routes. The County's [Bike Montco](#) countywide network does not call for bike lanes on this section of PA 611, because we recommend using the Jenkintown Road bridge and Rydal Road at-grade crossing to get across the SEPTA West Trenton Line, and avoid the extremely high volumes of vehicle traffic on 611. However, a short segment of 611 between Baeder Road and The Fairway is recommended for bicycle facilities as part of the County's priority network connecting Bryn Athyn and Glenside, so future 611 corridor projects should take bicycle mobility into account.
